

## Support for bushfire-declared communities

Today the Minister for Education, the Hon Dan Tehan MP <u>announced</u> a range of measures to support families in bushfire-declared communities. This includes additional mental health support and additional support for early childhood education and care.

On 15 January 2020, the Prime Minister also <u>announced</u> that families will receive an extra \$400 for each child aged under 16 that is eligible for the Australian Government Disaster Recovery Payment.
