


Response to the Four Week Review of the Early Childhood Education and Care Relief Package

The Australian Government has responded to the <u>Four Week Review of the Early</u> <u>Childhood Education and Care Relief Package</u> with the Minister for Education Dan Tehan <u>announcing</u> an additional \$12.8 million in funding to support services to continue to provide care for essential workers and vulnerable children. This new funding includes:

•\$12 million for child care services that have more than 30 per cent or more of full-time equivalent staff ineligible for the JobKeeper Payment. •\$800,000 to increase the level of funding for In Home Care providers.
